We thank all families who have been patient and diligent in getting forms completed. Your efforts are much appreciated and haven't gone unnoticed.



Dear Parents, Guardians, and Families,

We've completed our first full week of school, and it's great to see students settling into routines and understanding expectations. Parents, please continue to keep communication open and reach out to your child's teacher with any questions.

Yesterday, our hearts were heavy as we learned of the tragic events at Annunciation Catholic School and Church in Minneapolis. A sacred space meant for prayer and learning was disrupted by violence, and our thoughts and prayers are with the children, families, staff, and parish community there. We also recognize that news like this can cause fear and anxiety. Please know that the safety of everyone at St. Rose is our highest priority. Our staff is trained in emergency protocols, including lockdown and evacuation procedures, and we take all concerns seriously.

This week I would like to review attendance procedures:

Reporting an Absence: if your child will be absent, parents must call the attendance line (419-223-6361, option 1) by 7:55. Leave your name, your child's name and grade, and the reason for the absence (e.g., illnes, doctor's appointment). Please do not report absences through Class Dojo, as teachers may not see messages once class begins. If we don't receive a call, the school is required to contact you for safety reasons.

Written notes: a written note is required when your child returns. A doctor's note listing excused days may replace the parent note. If no doctor's note is provided, please send a parent note on the day your child returns. School staff will follow up when notes are missing.

Unexcused Absences & Truancy: If no call is received, the absence will be marked *unexcused*. Excessive unexcused absences may affect EdChoice Scholarships and count toward truancy.

Tardiness: Our tardy bell rings at 7:55 a.m., followed by announcements and morning lessons. Even a few minutes late causes students to miss important instruction and contributes toward truancy.

At. St. Rose Catholic School we are committed to working with you for your child's academic and spiritual growth. Regular, on-time attendance builds strong habits that support both learning and long-term success.
