Dear Parents, Guardians, and Families,

This week, students in Kindergarten through 8th grade began taking their fall MAP (Measures of Academic Performance) assessments. These assessments are given three times a year- fall (September), winter (January) and spring (April).

- Kindergarten-2nd grade: take 2 assessments
- 3rd-8th grade: take 4 assessments
- Each test takes about 45-60 minutes

To ensure students do their best, it's important that they:

- Arrive on time each day
- Get a good night's sleep
- Eat breakfast before school starts

Teachers may break up testing sessions over multiple days, especially for younger students, to prevent fatigue and ensure accurate results. Test results will be reviewed with families during fall conferences.

Dress Down Days & Special Dress Events

All dress down days are listed on the school calendar at srslima.org. Below is a quick overview: Spirit Day: The last Monday of school each month (not always the last calendar Monday). Students may wear:

- St. Rose spirit shirts (available at Ward Apparel)
- Plain Red or white shirts

Mission Jeans Day: Second Tuesday of each month, (mandatory \$1 donation). Proceeds support charities or families in need. Students may wear:

- Jeans or loose-fitting sweatpants
- A top of their choice (must be Catholic school appropriate)

Advent purple/pink shirt Monday's: First Monday of each week in Advent

- Purple shirts: Weeks 1, 2, and 4
- Pink shirts: Week 3
- Worn with uniform bottoms

Christmas Season Shirt Day: January 9. Students may wear Christmas-themed shirts or Christmas colors with uniform pants.

House Meeting Days: First Friday of each month.

- Students wear House shirts (or a plain shirt in their House color) with uniform bottoms.
- House meetings take place after Mass and Rosary.
- At the end of the quarter assemblies (October, December, March, May), House shirts are also worn
- Each student receives one House shirt; additional items will be available at Ward Apparel. More
 details will be sent home soon.

Birthday dress down days: Students may dress down on their birthday.

- If their birthday falls on a weekend, they may dress down the following Monday.
- Summer birthdays are celebrated with a "half-birthday" dress down day.

Other Dress Down Opportunities

Additional dress down days take place during:

- Red Ribbon Week (October)
- Catholic Schools Week (January)
- Right to Read Week (March)
- Positive Addiction Week (May)

Details will be shared in the Cardinal Review and on Class Dojo. If you are ever unsure about dress guidelines, please contact your child's teacher.
