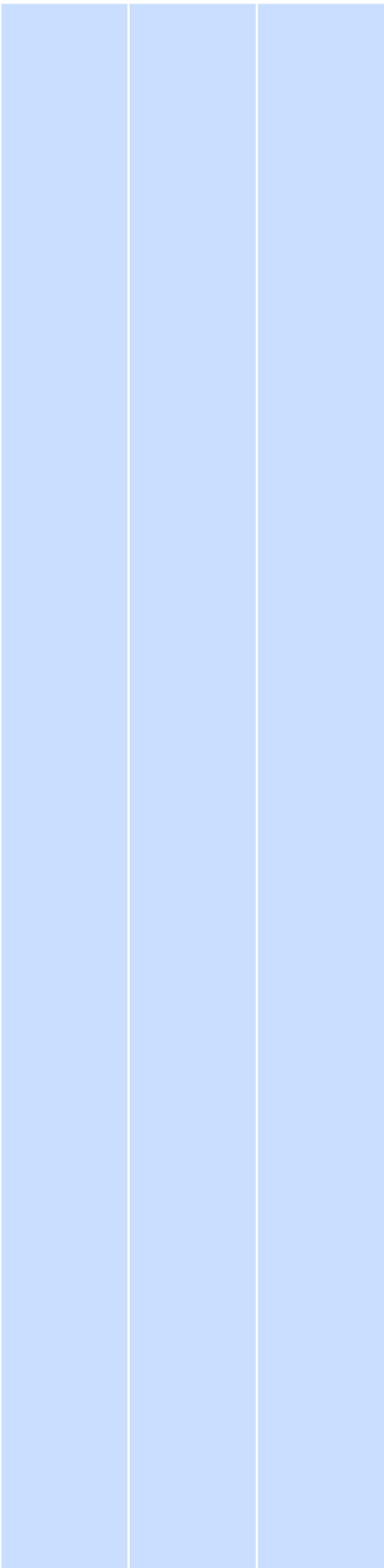

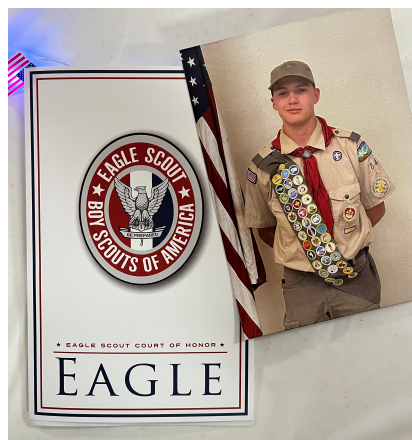

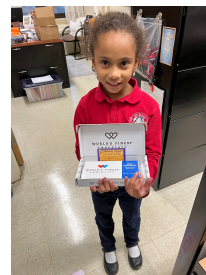

Dear Parents, Students and Families,

As we navigate the changing weather this week, it's a timely reminder of the importance of staying connected with our school community. To ensure you remain informed about important updates and announcements, we encourage you to sign up for at least one of our communication platforms: Remind app, Class Dojo, or Facebook. We post crucial information regarding any changes in the school schedule on all three platforms.

Personally, I recommend Class Dojo as my preferred method of communication. It allows teachers to share exciting classroom activities, send pictures, and provide updates on homework assignments. If you need assistance with signing up for any of these platforms, please don't hesitate to contact the office—we are here to help!

As discussed during Back to School Night and outlined in our Student/Parent Handbook, the four Lima Catholic Schools collaborate on weather-related decisions to ensure consistency for all families in our community. When two of the surrounding schools (Lima City, Elida, and Shawnee) decide to delay or cancel classes, we will follow their lead. These public school bus garages assess road conditions early in the morning to determine whether it is safe for buses to operate. There may be instances when we experience delays due to unsafe conditions on roads outside of town while in-town roads remain clear. We understand this can be frustrating, especially during inclement weather.

As we enter this time of year, I recommend checking your communication accounts (Remind, Class Dojo, and Facebook) each morning to stay updated on any developments. Additionally, students in grades 4-8 will be bringing home their mid-term reports this week. Please take a moment to review these reports with your child and return them signed to the school. If you have any questions or concerns, feel free to reach out to your child's teacher. Remember, the end of the quarter is approaching on December 20.
