1. Finalforms (Online Registration for 2025-26)

We are transitioning to FinalForms, an online registration system designed to streamline the enrollment process for families and improve efficiency for our staff. All families with students enrolled for the 2024-2025 school year (Preschool through 8th) should have received an email with instructions to create a FinalForms account and complete the necessary paperwork.

- Deadline: All forms must be completed by June 20.
- Need help? If you didn't receive the email or need assistance, please contact the school office. Computers are available at school to help you complete the forms if needed. Don't wait until June 20.
- 2. EdChoice/EdChoice Expansion (Tuition Scholarship Program)
  EdChoice materials are included in this mailing.
  - If you are completing the digital EdChoice application, you may download and submit it online to Finalforms. Don't forget to include a current utility bill.
  - If you prefer or are experiencing technical issues, a **hard copy** is included for your convenience. Please return the completed form and proof of address (current utility bill) to the school **no later than June 20.**
  - Kindergarten families applying for EdChoice Expansion (based on income)
    must complete the income application online in the EdChoice portal (OHID).
    Please contact the office if you need help with this process.

3. Outstanding balances

Statements for any outstanding balances related to fees, lunch charges and/or damages to books/chromebooks are enclosed. Please ensure all balances are paid in full by **June 20.** 

4. Report Cards

Your child's final report card is included. We encourage you to review it together-celebrate their successes and discuss areas for improvement. Daily reading over the summer is essential to prevent learning loss.

5. Spring MAP test results

Enclosed are your child's Spring MAP test results, along with a guide to help you understand the report.

6. Student Password Sheets

We've included your child's password sheet for logging into school-related online programs. These can be used over the summer to maintain academic skills.

7. School Supply Lists

Grades K-8 supply lists are included. Some items were removed due a large stock in inventory. Baggies, erasers, notebooks and filler paper are among items in stock.

### 8. Online Learning Resources

- Reading Eggs & Mathseeds: For building reading and math skills (K-5th grade). Just one hour a week in each program can make a significant difference.
- ALEKS: A math program for our junior high students.

#### KINDERGARTEN-8th grade girls

- -Plaid skirt (A+ Uniforms, P66). Length to be no shorter than 3" above the knee.
- -Navy blue shorts (April 1-October 31) (must be 65/35 poly-cotton blend)
- -Navy blue pants (must be 65/35 poly-cotton blend)
- -White Polo Shirt (short or long sleeve) (no logo required)
- -Red Polo Shirt (short or long sleeve) (no logo required)
- -White Peter Pan Collared Blouse (short or long sleeve)
- -White Oxford Shirt (short or long sleeve)
  - It is suggested that a PLAIN WHITE undershirt be worn under blouses/oxford shirts for modesty purposes.
- -Navy cardigan sweater (A+ Uniforms)
- -Navy V-neck pullover sweater (A+ Uniforms)
- -Navy sweater vest (A+ Uniforms)
- -Navy 1/4 zip pullover (school-logo embroidered) (A+ Uniforms)
- -Girls tights-white, navy
- -Socks-white, navy (low or knee socks)
- -Girls 5-8-plain navy, brown or black belt

### SCHOOL SHOES: LEATHER or CLOTH

- Oxford-style (closed 2" heel or lower, 1 1/4" tread or less on sole)
- tie, saddle (closed 2" heel or lower, 1 1/4" tread or less on sole)
- slip-on loafer style (closed 2" heel or lower, 1 1/4" tread or less on sole)
- Must be below the ankle. Hiking, weather or casual boots are not acceptable.
- Brown, Tan, Black, White or Navy. No adornments visible.
- Plain and solid is the rule (no sequins, sparkles, plaid, decorative eyelet holes, or shoestrings, etc.)

ATHLETIC SHOES: Black, white, navy, brown, or tan and must be all one color. The sole, logo and heel must be the same color.

### **GRADES K - 8 BOYS**

- -Navy Blue Uniform Shorts (April 1-October 31) (must be 65/35 poly-cotton blend)
- -Navy Blue Uniform Pants (must be 65/35 poly-cotton blend)
- -White Polo Shirt (short or long sleeve) (no logo required)
- -Red Polo Shirt (short or long sleeve) (no logo required)
- -White Oxford Shirt (short or long sleeve) (required for grades 6-8 with tie)
  - It is suggested that a PLAIN WHITE undershirt be worn under oxford shirts for modesty purposes.
- -Socks-White, Navy, Black (must cover the ankle)
- -Boys 5-8-plain navy, brown or black belt
- -Boys 6-8 navy blue embroidered tie (must be purchased through Ward Apparel)
- -Navy cardigan sweater (A+ Uniforms)
- -Navy V-neck pullover sweater (A+ Uniforms)
- -Navy sweater vest (A+ Uniforms)
- -Navy 1/4 zip pullover (school-logo embroidered) (A+ Uniforms)

### -SCHOOL SHOES: LEATHER or CLOTH
